

Using An Unmounted Stamp

- Trim the excess rubber using a sharp pair of scissors.
- Use Sticky Dots or other temporary adhesive to affix the stamp to an acrylic block. If you choose to use this method, use a soft surface (eg mouse mat) under your paper as you print
- Alternatively, mount the stamp on a piece of Form-a-Foam, or similar material, using Sticky Dots or similar glue. In this case you can stamp onto a hard surface.
- Clean stamps after use
- Unmounted stamps can be used in many innovative ways
 - Only ink up part of the stamp to give a distressed look
 - Use to impress into Friendly Plastic® etc.
 - Instead of printing, take a rubbing with a soft crayon/pencil and thinner paper
 - Arrange your collage of unmounted stamps on a large acrylic block for the look of a vintage collection.
